To apply for a Colebrook Associates, Inc. Scholarship, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. The applicant must be a resident of Colebrook.
- 2. The applicant must be continuing his/her education as a new or continuing student.
- 3. Education must be at an accredited four-year, two-year, or certificate-granting institution. (Scholarships are not granted for career-related continuing education or graduate programs).
- 4. A completed scholarship application must be submitted by the due date.
- 5. Applications must include a letter of recommendation from a non-related adult. This must be a teacher, coach, supervisor, community leader or other professional.
- 6. <u>Include the most current official transcript of grades at the time of application.</u> <u>Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted.</u>
- 7. <u>Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered.</u>
- 8. If there are extenuating circumstances related to your scholarship application requiring additional time in school to earn your bachelor's degree, provide a detailed explanation.
- 9. All applications must be postmarked or electronically submitted by April 30th, at 11:59PM.
